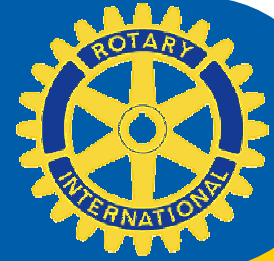

Sister Georgette thanked the Toronto East Rotary Club for their past sponsorships in helping to establish the mini-park and garden in front of their building on Queen Street East in 2003 and for their annual Spring clean up.

Sister Georgette and Leanne elaborated on the founding and history of Fontbonne and provided an overview of the many aspects of service Fontbonne is involved in. Its programs include a pottery studio, a sewing program, foot care for seniors, computer training, a bridge card playing social event, a lunch program on Saturdays, a visitation program for seniors, Bible story sessions and other programs and events. The premises on Queen Street are permanent housing for 18 women over the age of 40, some of whom have disabilities. There are only three salaried individuals on staff and Fontbonne receives no Government funding.
